One \$500 scholarship is available to Cheboygan County students. Qualifications include:

4. The Cheboygan County Farm Bureau selects the recipient.
5. The scholarship check will be paid to the order of the student.
6. Should a school semester or term not be completed for any reason other than illness, the money will be returned.

The scholarship application will be available in the guidance office . It does require three letters of recommendation. The deadline is April 15, 2016.

A MHS staff member will present this scholarship at graduation.
